

# Pixler

## A web browser image editor

Many times your web site will require an image to be an 'exact' size to fit in the box or area designed for that image. We find that the plug-in 'Pixler' ( <http://pixlr.com/> ) that is available for web browsers is the easiest way to edit your images without expensive software.

### Selecting an Image

On the Web, find image that you want to edit

RT-click on image  
SELECT Edit image in Pixler

The Image will open in new window/tab

### Re-size Image

SELECT Image / Image Size  
CHOOSE Largest Size - Height or Width  
CHANGE To desired largest size  
SELECT OK

### For Square Image

(will add white space on smaller side of image)

SELECT Image / Canvas Size  
SELECT Center Square (will turn blue)  
CHANGE Smallest size to equal the Largest size  
SELECT OK

### Save edited Image

SELECT File / Save  
NAME Name the file so it is easily found (see naming notes below)  
FORMAT Default of .jpg @ 80% quality is usually good  
SELECT OK - Will open location window  
CHOOSE Location to save image

### Close Image / Pixler

When you choose to close the image or Pixler, you will be asked if you want to save the image again. You can answer NO. This question is prompting if you want to save in another format for future use.

### NOTES:

#### Open an Image on your Computer

Open your web browser and goto: <http://pixlr.com/editor/> (save to favorites)  
SELECT Open Image from Computer  
FIND Find image to edit  
SELECT Open

#### Image Names - When naming images keep some of these things in mind

Subject, blog post title, item #  
Size: 400x300 or 400 (if square)  
Date: year month day will always sort well in a folder  
20120725 = July 25, 2012
